



Standard Follow-Up Report: Transit Adjudication Bureau, 1st Quarter 2023

The purpose of this quarterly report is to update the Transit Committee on Transit Adjudication Bureau (TAB) activities and outcomes, as reflected by several Key Indicators.

TAB is the statutory administrative tribunal that receives, processes, adjudicates and pursues collection of civil penalties arising from the tens of thousands of civil summonses that are issued each year for violations of the Transit Rules of Conduct.

This quarterly reporting on TAB activities and outcomes commenced in 1992. The report provides the Committee with metrics, covering the most recently completed quarter, for the following Key Indicators:

- Number of TAB violations received by TAB
- Number and dollar amount of payments TAB received
- TAB revenues and expenses for the quarter
- Number of cases adjudicated

STANDARD FOLLOW-UP REPORTS: TRANSIT ADJUDICATION BUREAU FIRST QUARTER 2023

The following is a comparison of the key indicators for the first quarter of 2023 as compared to the same period in 2022:

- Summonses issued in the first quarter increased by 80% (from 30,382 in 2022 to 54,692 in 2023).
- TAB received 33,402 payments in 2023, a 79.3% increase from the 18,633 received in 2022. Direct payments increased by 94.3% (14,944 to 29,041) from the first quarter of 2022 and payments received from state tax refunds increased 18.2% from 3,689 to 4,361.
- Overall total revenue for the first quarter totaled \$3,353,234, a 66.8% increase from the 2022 first quarter revenue of \$2,010,571. Receipts from direct payments increased by 89.1% to \$2,702,146 in 2023 as compared to \$1,428,983 in the first quarter of 2022. The \$692,465 in first quarter receipts from state tax refunds relating to outstanding judgments from prior years, represented a 16.4% increase from first quarter state tax refunds of \$594,965 in 2022.
- Expenses increased by 18.9% (\$1,087,738 compared to \$914,606) from the first quarter of 2022.
- TAB revenue exceeded expenses by \$2,265,496 compared to \$1,095,956 for the first quarter of 2022.
