Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Changes in Traffic Pattern and Parking Removal on Bronxdale Avenue between Poplar Street and Sackett Avenue

The Penn Station Access Project will need to implement intermittent changes to traffic patterns on Bronxdale Ave between Poplar Street and Sackett Avenue to safely complete work on the Bronxdale Ave Bridge - track and bridge structure.

Bronxdale Avenue is currently limited to one travel lane in each direction in this area. This next phase of work will see both northbound and southbound traffic shifted to the southbound lane. This configuration will be in place from October 14th, 2024, and last for about one (1) month. Pedestrian access will also be closed on the northbound side and a five-foot protected pedestrian walkway will be maintained on the southbound side.

We will continue to update the community as work on the Bronxdale Ave Bridge progresses in the coming months. These closures are necessary to safely perform track work and substructure repairs on the Bronxdale Ave Bridge situated above the roadway.

We appreciate your understanding and patience while we advance this vital transit equity project.
