Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

## Intermittent Changes in Traffic Pattern and Parking Removal on Bronxdale Avenue between Poplar Street and Sackett Avenue


The Penn Station Access project will need to implement intermittent changes to traffic patterns on Bronxdale Ave between Poplar Street and Sackett Avenue to safely complete work on the Bronxdale Ave Bridge - track and bridge structure.

One travel lane in each direction and the parking lanes on northbound and southbound Bronxdale Avenue will be closed. The roadway will be limited to one travel lane in each direction. Pedestrian access will be maintained on both sides. This next phase of work to begin the week of April 15th, 2024 will last for approximately 3 months.

Traffic patterns will continue to shift throughout the duration of the project.

We will continue to update the community as work on the Bronxdale Avenue Bridge progresses in the coming months. These closures are necessary to safely perform track work and substucture repairs on the Bronxdale Avenue Bridge situated above the roadway.

We appreciate your understanding and patience while we advance this vital transit equity project.
