## **PURPOSE:**

This is to inform the Long Island Committee of the MTA Long Island Rail Road's plan to temporarily adjust schedules to support a series of Switch Installations and Track Maintenance on the Port Jefferson Branch, ADA Station Rehabilitation at Laurelton, and Track Maintenance between Queens Village and Jamaica.

## TRACK WORK PROGRAMS

Construction Activities (Short-term trackwork items requiring a special program)

- Port Jefferson Branch Switch Installation and Track Maintenance On the weekends of June 29-30, July 13-14, July 20-21, July 27-28, and August 3-4, both main tracks between Hicksville and Port Jefferson will be taken out of service for a period of approximately 48-hours to support a series of switch installations, as well as rail replacement and bridge maintenance at various locations on the Port Jefferson Branch.
  - Temporary Service Adjustments: With both main tracks out of service between Hicksville and Port Jefferson, bus service will replace train service for approximately 48-hours.
- Atlantic Branch ADA Station Rehabilitation Laurelton On the weekends of June 29-30, July 13-14, July 20-21, July 27-28, and August 3-4, both main tracks on the Atlantic Branch between Jamaica and Valley Stream will be out of service to support the ADA Accessibility Project at Laurelton.
  - O **Temporary Service Adjustments:** With both main tracks out of service on the Atlantic Branch between Jamaica and Valley Stream, bus service will replace train service to/from Locust Manor, Laurelton, and Rosedale for a period of 48-hours.

- Main Line Maintenance The local westbound track that services Elmont-UBS Arena, Queens Village, and Hollis will be taken out of service Monday through Thursday between July 8<sup>th</sup> and July 25<sup>th</sup> during the midday period, as track maintenance is performed.
  - Temporary Service Adjustments: With the local westbound track out of service between Queens Village and Jamaica, NYCTA Bus will cross-honor customers at Queens Village and Hollis Stations. There will be no westbound service from Elmont-UBS Arena during these timeframes. Customers are encouraged to utilize Bellerose Station for westbound train service to Jamaica.

## IMPACT ON FUNDING

Funding for these projects is contained in the Long Island Rail Road Operating and MTA Capital Program budget.
