



Infrastructure

- Expediting Water Intrusion Management (Annual goal 5000 locations)
- Clearing Drain Boxes and Pipes (miles)
- Vent Cleaning
- Defect Correction
- Security Emergency Response Team (SERT)
 Coordination





Fire Mitigation Efforts

- Replacing fiberglass insulators with monocoated or thermoplastic (new standard)
- Improved tracking water intrusion to coordinate leak repairs
- Targeted cleaning and trash receptacle service such as during holiday events and high-volume stations
- Train Fires
 - Cable crimp manufacturing issue identified and addressed as scheduled maintenance is performed





Fire Mitigation Efforts

Track Fires

- New switch lubrication fully adopted; less flammable
- Coordination of Vac Train and Station Cleaning
- Improved directing resources to address more areas
- Infrastructure focused on repairing paper catchers
- Application of fire-retardant coating to high incident tie fire locations
