How we redesigned the bus network

Rider Priorities and Redesign Strategies

Riders identified the following **four priorities**:



Reliable Service



Faster Travel



Better Connections



Simplified Service

The project team used **seven redesign strategies**:

- Improve Route Design
- Enhance Connectivity
- Improve Frequency
- Balance Bus Stops
- Expand Bus Priority with NYC DOT
- Improve Transit Equity
- Improve Accessibility

Introducing Route Types

Local Routes (Green) Connecting local neighborhoods

Limited Routes (Red) Serving high demand corridors with frequent service

SBS Routes (Blue) Connecting key destinations across longer distances

Express Routes (Dark Green)


Connecting outer borough neighborhoods directly to Manhattan

Rush Routes (Purple)

Connecting outer borough neighborhoods quickly to bus and subway hubs




Q85 Rush Route



Service from Rosedale to Jamaica

- Serves Merrick Blvd corridor
- Local stop spacing between Rosedale and Merrick Blvd corridor
- Rush segment on Merrick Blvd
- Serves key destinations along Merrick Blvd
- Provides faster service to key transfer points in Jamaica
- Underlying local service provided by the Q5

Q111 Rush Route



Service from Rosedale to Jamaica

- Serves Guy R Brewer Blvd corridor
- Local stop spacing on 147th Avenue
- Rush segment on Guy R Brewer Blvd
- Serves key destinations along Guy R Brewer Blvd
- Provides faster service to key transfer points in Jamaica
- Underlying local service provided by the Q115




124 total routes (vs. 113 existing)

94 Local routes (vs. 83 existing) including 25 Rush Routes
30 Express routes (vs. 30 existing)

Highlights:

36 major routing changes17 routes with increased frequencies8 routes with increased spans
