ON YOUR TRAIN

Bicycles: You may bring your bicycle on the train if you have a Metro-North or Long Island Rail Road bicycle permit. Generally, bicycles may be brought on off-peak trains only, subject to limits on the number of bicycles on the train. Bicycles are not permitted on inbound AM peak trains and outbound PM peak trains, any train with the symbol, or on holidays as indicated in the bicycle regulations.
