### Metro-North's Simulator Room Makes Broadcast News!

Metro-North Railroad's Simulator Training facility was the subject of a recent NBC Channel 4 News exclusive report.

NBC4 reporter Andrew Siff was on the scene where he got a chance to see how our engineers are being trained on locomotive simulators for the Positive Train Control system.



Speaking to Siff was Deputy Director of Transportation Training **Wayne McNeil**, who said, "Everything we do hinges on safety. We want to get our engineers trained on PTC before the system is implemented."

Siff noted that engineers are first trained in a classroom setting before moving on to the simulators. Locomotive Engineer, **Diane Quattlebaum**, demonstrated for the NBC 4 cameras how the system works.

On Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 28,

we will operate an enhanced Sunday schedule with additional inbound trains and cars for those of you heading to the 9 AM Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade.

And we will have plenty of additional outbound service to get you hom e to the dinner table.

Here's our recipe for happy Thanksgiving travel:

Buy your tickets in advance (like your turkey-or for the vegans among us, your plantbased meat substitutes). Thanksgiving is one of the busiest travel days of the year, and if you're leaving New York after the parade, you must have your ticket before boarding your train at Grand Central or Harlem-125th Street Station. Again, we suggest you use  $\textbf{MTA eTtix}^{\texttt{R}}$  on your iPhone or Android (you'll be 'thankful' you did!)

On the Day after Thanksgiving, Friday, November 29,

an enhanced Saturday schedule will be in effect with additional AM inbound and PM outbound trains, so you can take advantage of all those Black Friday sales or simply enjoy the special retail window decorations.

On Saturday and Sunday, November 30 and December 1,

we will provide regular weekend schedules with additional capacity on trains.

## Grand Central Terminal has a new neighbor

# One Vanderbilt Tops Out at 1,401 Feet

One Vanderbilt, the enormous building flanking the south west side of Grand Central Terminal, has now topped out. "Topped out" means the core structure has reached its ultimate height.

The developer, SL Green, says the project is several months ahead of schedule, and should open in about a year with an observation deck hovering 1,000 feet above the city.

#### It will bring approximately \$220 million in transit improvements to East Midtown,

including refurbishing the Grand Central subway mezzanine level providing more access to the street level. Most of the transit funds will be used to make improvements on the NYC Transit (4) (5) (6) lines.





between One Vanderbilt and the subway, Long Island Rail Road East Side Access (expected in 2022) and the west side of Grand Central Terminal near the Station Master's Office In addition, One Vanderbilt will include a 4,000square foot public transit hall on the ground floor.

And those who aren't in a hurry to get anywhere can take a seat in the new car-free pedestrian plaza and watch the world go by.


