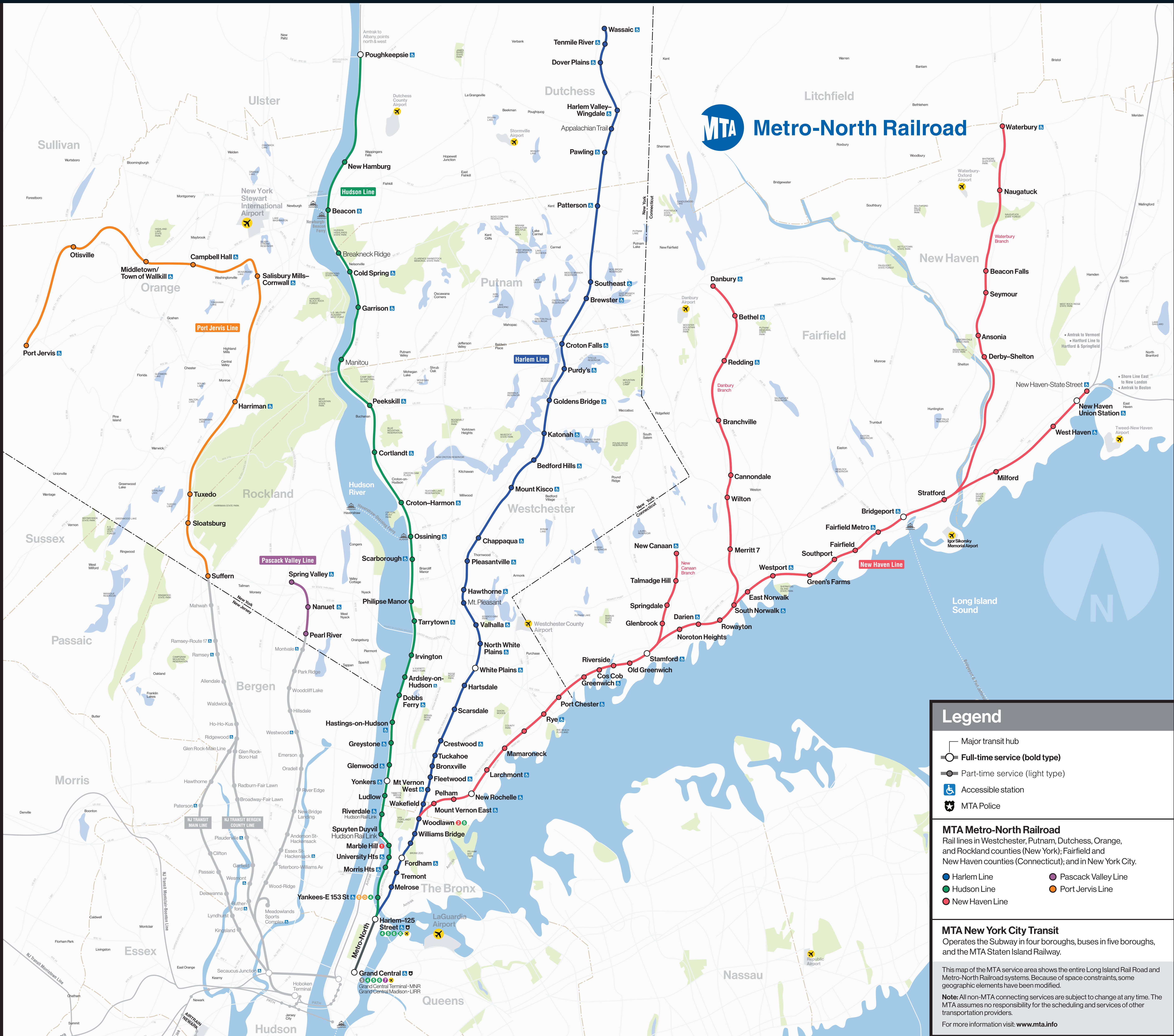


Metro-North Railroad
